### **Our History**

The University of Toronto Campus Safety organization has been an institution on the St. George campus since 1904. During that time, the organization has evolved to provide services that address the changing needs of the University.

Training has also progressed to facilitate our new role in the community. The inclusion of training modules that support the academic mission recognizes our support role to the University mission.

### Who are Special Constables?

Special Constables are appointed by the Province of Ontario through the Toronto Police Services Board.

- They have the authority of a peace officer while on University property.
- They are able to deal with criminal and provincial offences, thereby requiring less Toronto Police presence on campus.
- They have a philosophy that promotes safety and support over enforcement and detention.
- They have diverse educational backgrounds including Social Work, Psychology, Criminology, Kinesiology and Health Sciences to name a few.



### **Our Services**

In addition to providing core safety & security services to the University community, we also offer other services to enhance your safety. Some of these include:

#### **TravelSafer**

A Campus Safety Special Constable or Building Patroller (Security) can escort you to and from U of T buildings and abutting TTC stations. This service is available 24/7, 365 days a year to all campus users!

#### WorkAlone

U of T community members can register to receive regular check-ins from Campus Safety Communications while working alone on campus. We've got your back.

#### **Buy and Sell Exchange Zone**

We invite you to use the Campus Safety office lobby as a safer alternative to buy and sell your items that have been arranged through an online marketplace.

### **Campus Safety Tips**

Here are our top five safety tips to be aware of to enhance your safety on campus:

- 1) Personal Safety Minimize distractions while travelling on campus to help you stay alert to your surroundings.
- 2) Theft Prevention Keep valuables and belongings within your reach and sight. Treat them like you would money and don't leave them unattended.
- 3) Online Safety Check your privacy settings on social media accounts. Connect with people you know.
- **4) Transit Safety** Avoid displaying money in public. Have your fare ready for payment when taking public transit.
- 5) Vehicle Safety Lock it or lose it! Avoid leaving valuables in your vehicle or ensure you secure them out of sight.
